- Robbie mentioned he has a new computer for Kevin, an HP Stream Notebook.
- Bob was asked about his progress on his workshop.
- Michael showed SIO MIDI devices and played some music.
- Rod liked how you can add to Michael's device forever.
- Michael spoke about his A8 Pico Card, his FujiNet, And 85 MIDI files, with MIDI Car Player.
- Scott said his 130 XE had a MIDI pin... MIDI Mate plugged into a SIO port for 8 Bit.
- Michael had no sound with FujiNet, so he got out a voltmeter and the line was low. He showed a 3D printed box for MIDI.
- Kevin wants a plug and play upgrade for MEGA ST to run 50 MHz. Old boards were huge, but now Plug and Play.
