- ****Meeting Participants****: Kevin, Robbie, Bill, Don, Bob, Ron.
- ****Technical Issues****: Initial audio issues were resolved, and discussions about using Zoom's transcription feature were mentioned.
- ****Bill's AI Audio Summary****:
